

Barclay Firth Pandemic Response

Barclay Firth take the health and safety of our site teams, staff and visitors very seriously and in light of the current Covid-19 pandemic, we have been actively reviewing and updating our working practices and guidelines in line with latest government advice and legislation. The goal of these measures is to minimize direct contact that could spread the coronavirus (Covid-19), whilst balancing business continuity.

In response to government guidelines issued on 11th May 2020, Barclay Firth have updated our Pandemic Response Policy and our Site Risk Assessment documentation accordingly.

We have also taken steps to ensure compliance by providing a Site Check List, a self-declaration form for all visitors to our project sites, improved site signage in key areas, increased cleaning rota's and the provision of further wash facilities and hand sanitiser product on all sites. All non-essential office staff are working currently from home.

The Site Check List outlines our current working practises on all construction sites, namely that all team members and contractors should maintain a distance of 2 metres apart, that all delivery drivers should remain in their vehicles whilst goods are unloaded, that all visitors should sign a self-declaration document and that all essential meetings should take place outside or in a well ventilated area whilst maintaining the social distancing rules.

Full compliance is expected whilst we move through Phase 1 of the UK Government's Covid-19 Recovery Strategy and all documents and guidelines will be updated in line with new government guidelines as they become available.
